**Water Conservation Ordinance (Source: <http://savedallaswater.coordinance>)**

The guidelines in the [Water Conservation Ordinance](#) are intended to conserve water and extend the life of existing infrastructure by minimizing the stress on the system caused by the peak demand of summer water usage. By using water wisely, we can help delay infrastructure expansion (primarily water treatment facilities and delivery systems) and the need for additional water resources (buying additional water rights to existing reservoirs or building new reservoirs). Outdoor water usage can be more than 50% of our total summer water use. By controlling this use we can minimize its impact on our current infrastructure and future expansion.

**The Conservation Ordinance Outdoor Watering Guidelines**

- Maximum twice-weekly watering allowed according to address (see chart below).
- Don't water your yard between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. between April 1 and October 31.
- Hand water or use a soaker hose. Both are permitted on any day.
- Maintain your sprinkler system. Repair any broken, missing or misdirected sprinkler heads.
- Automatic sprinkler system owners are required to have rain and freeze sensors installed.
- Don't water during any form of precipitation.
- Don't allow your sprinkler system to water driveways, sidewalks and streets.

City of Dallas Maximum Twice Per Week Watering Schedule	
Last Digit of Address	Watering Days Allowed
0, 2, 4, 6 or 8 (even numbers)	Sundays and Thursdays
1, 3, 5, 7 or 9 (odd numbers)	Saturdays and Wednesdays
No address number	Sundays and Thursdays

Don't waste water by allowing runoff onto a street or other drainage area when you're watering. Violations of these outdoor water guidelines can result in fines of \$250 to \$2,000 per incident. First offenses will be issued a warning.

## TRY OUT WITH DALLAS UNITED CREW!



Members of the Dallas United Crew High School Rowing Team attended the US Rowing Club National Championships in Oak Ridge, Tennessee on July 19-20 with great performances. Under Coach Randy Dam, the Men's Junior 8+ boat placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the Grand Final against tough competition. Additionally, the DUC Men's Intermediate 8+ and Men's Junior 4+ had strong showings in their events.

After finishing their regular spring season, the DUC rowers trained for an additional 6 weeks before traveling and racing at Nationals. The men's commitment to training included early morning water sessions six days a week and physical training in the afternoons at DUC's land training partner, CrossFit Lake Highlands. All the hard work and preparation paid off. The national rowing community is paying attention to Dallas United Crew's rowing program with these great performances. The DUC Men's Jr. 8+ beat out every United States Junior High Performance Team boat and even an official United States U-23 High Performance Team boat.
